REQUEST (Work Session)

City staff has been discussing with the Idaho Gold Star Families Memorial Monument Committee Chairperson (Rebecca Webb) and Developers on a request for the City of Pocatello to approve and support the placement of a Gold Star Families Memorial Monument in the Northgate Development.

The Idaho Gold Star Families Memorial Monument Committee and others will share their vision and proposed options for a Memorial Monument to be placed on future City owned property in the Northgate Development. They will provide Council with information on the proposed project, and to seek any other input and/or direction the Council may have.

Back Ground

The area for the proposed monument would be on an open space lot that will be dedicated to the City through the recorded plat “The Crossings Division 1” already approved by the City Council. The remainder of the open space for this project will be dedicated if approved on a future plat (to be known as the “Northgate District”) that will be presented to City Council.

The group has been in contact with John Banks, City Park and Recreation Director and has discussed informally with the Park and Recreation Advisory Board. Council may wish the group be placed on the April 4, 2019 Agenda of the Park and Recreational Advisory Board for formal action. The group is willing to fund and construct the monument, parking lot, and landscaping. Once complete the request is the City to take over ownership and maintenance.
