In follow-up to our letter dated December 26, 2019, we have spoken to our City Liaison, John Banks from Parks and Recreation. John had spoken to Cindy Robbins in utility billing to address our water charge concerns and to clarify and confirm the remaining amount owed to Fore Golf.

As a result, FORE Golf respectfully requests that the City of Pocatello consider our revised (and confirmed) request of \$28,801.90 for break repair expenses incurred due to on-going water delivery issues at the Riverside Golf Course.


In light of unfavorable play trends during the 2016 – 2018 seasons, granting of this request would allow FORE Golf to address remaining 2018 season financial obligations, and aid tremendously in preparing for the 2019 season, when the courses open and we begin to generate revenues.

FORE Golf is extremely grateful to you and the City Council for granting much needed financial relief for the 2018 season in the form of base payment & water service obligation reductions and reimbursements for break repair expenses incurred, and we thank you once again for your consideration of our request. We are well underway with re-negotiation discussions with director Banks in regards to terms & conditions of the Golf Concession Agreement, and look forward to continued operation of the Highland & Riverside Golf Courses for our community.
