## $\approx$ Stray Cat Population

$\%$ The shelter euthanized almost 383 cats and 585 kittens last year, many were more akin to wildlife than domestic pets.

## Unleashed Dogs

$*$ The presence of unleashed dogs, especially in parks and on trails has led to both animal on animal and animal on citizen issues.

## Lack of Spay / Neuter Resources

$\%$ While there are private sector resources for low cost spay/neuter these resources fall short of being able to impact shelter intake and animal population.
Citizen's responsibility for cleaning up after their pets
$\%$ Animal Services receives many complaints about citizens not picking up after their pets, this not only includes public places, but neighborhoods as well.
