# FY18 Service Summary City Hall (Custodial and Facility Maintenance) Department

#### • Mission:

• Provide cleaning and maintenance for the facility housing City Hall – Police Department, additional city owned facilities as requested by specific departments (Transit, Sanitation, Zoo, PPD substations) and city owned buildings, including buildings we lease out.

#### FY18 Service Output Summary

- Custodial Staff
  - 4 Full time equivalent positions
  - 1 Part time positions
- Cleans and maintains
  - Excess of 150,000 square feet
  - 52 weeks of operation

## Service Measures of Effectiveness, Key Accomplishments:

- Efforts to refurbish the cosmetic character of City Hall. The building has been our municipal offices location for the past 25 years with minimal upgrades.
- The custodial staff offer services to all City departments who request assistance for in-house services. The external buildings are charged for actual expenditures and this is accomplished with an inter fund transfer entry.

### Service Measures of Effectiveness, Key Accomplishments:

- Respond to service requests timely
- Provide special cleaning requests for departments that require the use of our specialized equipment.
- Strive to utilize improved equipment and upgrades to our operating systems such as our HVAC and electrical systems to best utilize our energy consumption.
- Administer and utilize an internet based HVAC control system throughout City Hall and Police Department facilities.

#### Service Issues and Concerns:

- City Hall and the Police Department structure is getting older and maintenance needs are growing.
  - Parking Lot
  - Upgrade/Replace HVAC system
  - Interior/Exterior paint
  - Carpet in City Hall
  - Door and hardware replacement
- The Department may need to expand the custodial staff with the addition of new City owned facilities or if additional departments elect to utilize our services.
  - The increased costs would be covered by the funds of the department requesting the services.
